## Notes

Chemistry electives must be at or above the 200 level.

Open electives should be chosen in consultation with a Carlow faculty advisor and can be used to complete a minor or specialization.

Students enrolling at Carlow must complete a *minimum* of 30 credits at Carlow to achieve residency. They also must complete a *minimum* of 18 credits within their major at Carlow.

## **Transfer of Credit Policies**

- Courses are at or above the 100 level and are not developmental or remedial in nature
- Courses were completed with a letter grade on the A+ through F grading scale (No P, S, or other grades are accepted at Carlow University)
  - 3. Courses were completed with a **minimum** grade of C or better
  - 4. A maximum of 90 total credits can be accepted for transfer

<sup>\*60-61</sup> credits are required to complete the Westmoreland program. 120 total credits are required to complete the Carlow program.
