## Notes

Students can choose a general Psychology track or use open electives to complete a Counseling, Child Development or Crisis \& Trauma specialization. They can also use open electives to complete a minor.

Students enrolling at Carlow must complete a minimum of 30 credits at Carlow to achieve residency. They also must complete a minimum of 18 credits within their major at Carlow.

Transfer of Credit Policies

1. Courses are at or above the 100 level and are not developmental or remedial in nature
2. Courses were completed with a letter grade on the A+ through F grading scale (No P, S, or other grades are accepted at Carlow University)
3. Courses were completed with a minimum grade of $C$ or better
4. A maximum of 90 total credits can be accepted for transfer
*63 credits are required to complete the Westmoreland program. 120 total credits are required to complete the Carlow program.
