Application Deadline: January 12 (fall start) or May 15 (spring start)

Thank you for your interest in Westmoreland County Community College’s **Expanded Functions Dental Assisting (EFDA) Certificate** program. This program has requirements in addition to the Application for Admission to the college. Use the checklist below to ensure that you successfully complete all of the requirements to apply to the program.

- **Become** a Westmoreland student by applying at <https://apply.westmoreland.edu/>
- **Submit** an official transcript from your high school (or proof of GED) and from any other colleges attended. A final official transcript must be sent after graduation (high school) if accepted.
- **Schedule** your placement assessment at https://westmoreland.edu/admissions_aid/apply/placement-assessment-educational-planning.html

NOTE: completion of developmental courses may be required based on the results of the placement assessment. Developmental courses do not count in your Westmoreland GPA.

- **Submit** all official documentation that applies
 - Dental Assisting National Board Certification or CDA
 - Current Dental Hygiene license (registered Dental Hygienist)
 - If employee trained: signed letter from employing dentist stating competencies
 - College or Trade School transcript
- **Complete and Submit** the Health Professions Program Application.
