Act 155: 17-Year-olds Completing Interior Firefighter

- Students that are 17 years of age enrolled in the ELIF class on the first day of class will be permitted to complete ELIF with "Live Fire, if:
- Westmoreland's Act 155 Permission Form is properly completed by the Fire Chief and associated parents and/or guardians and returned to the lead instructor by two (2) classes.
- The student MUST submit a copy of all the prerequisites with the Westmoreland Act 155 Permission Form.
- Students that fall under Act 155 requirements that DO NOT return, complete, and/or provide an incomplete form/supporting documents will be IMMEDIATELY removed from class, and will not be permitted to return to the current class.
- Students that successfully complete the Act 155 Interior Firefighter are NOT permitted to participate in any other "Live Fire" training and/or interior suppression activities till the individual meets the age of 18 and is approved by the fire department to do so.
- This includes individuals that have completed an approved vocational program.

REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

- 2024 Registration will be available starting December 9.
- PRE-REGISTRATION is required to ensure sufficient enrollment. Registration available at:
 - Preferred Method by College Self-Registration System

- Students must meet the age requirement established by the State Fire Academy (PSFA) by the starting date of the program.
 - Proof of age can be required and should be available upon request.
- Students with facial hair will not be permitted to participate in programs requiring the use of breathing apparatus per PSFA standards.
- Students will be required to provide their own classroom materials, personal protection equipment, including breathing apparatus, work clothes and safety equipment as required for the program.
- Students are required to provide proof that the prerequisite training has been completed.
- A copy of the pre-requisite certificate must be provided the first night of class to be accepted into the program.
- Students will be notified by e-mail of specific course information upon registration. A minimum number of students shall be required for any program.
 - Programs will be cancelled, also by email notification, if the minimum number of students for the class to run safely is not met.
- All classes require a minimum of ten (10) students, unless otherwise specified
- Maximum class is thirty (30) unless otherwise specified
- Classes not meeting minimum enrollment five (5) days prior to the start date WILL BE CANCELED
 - Tuition fees will be refunded if a program is canceled.
 - If you are unable to attend a course after registration, your cancellation must be received prior to the first program date to guarantee a refund or to guarantee that you are not billed as a student of the class.
- Students SHOULD arrive 15-minutes prior to start of class, with pen and paper.

Certificates of Completion

• Certificates of Completion will be received electronically via your provided email and, depending on time of year, may take up to 30-days to be processed and emailed out.

Westmoreland County Fire Departments

- Pending availability, Westmoreland County Fire Departments can schedule 3-8 hour special training FREE of charge at the PSTC.
- A completed facility usage form is required and can be located at the PSTC website under Facilities.
- A certificate of training for these sessions is also available but would require the use of a PSTC approved instructor at a cost of \$10 per student, with a minimum of ten (10) students.
- Due to new NFPA 1403 standards use of the Class A burn building by a department is no longer permitted.
 Private department burns are still permitted and encouraged but must use the PSTC staff.

Out-of-County Fire Departments

- Rental of the PSTC is available to out-of-county fire departments.

Acquired Structure Burns

- The PSTC is willing to facilitate "Acquired Structure Burns." The burn must meet all DEP and PSFA documentation requirements which will be the responsibility of the owner/hosting fire department.
