




Unduplicated 12-month headcount and total FTE, by student level: 2020-21






### Percent of all students enrolled, by race/ethnicity: Fall 2021





# Graduation rates of full-time, first-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduates within normal time, and 150% and 200% of normal time to completion: 2017 cohort







# Award and enrollment rates of degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who entered the institution in 2013-14, by cohort








#### **Students not receiving Pell Grants**

Percent of part-time, first-time entering students receiving an award at four, six, and eight years after entry, by type of award and Pell status




Percent of full-time, non-first-time entering students receiving an award at four, six, and eight years after entry, by type of award and Pell status


Percent of part-time, non-first-time entering students receiving an award at four, six, and eight years after entry, by type of award and Pell status


Percent distribution of core revenues, by source: Fiscal year 2021




