- ☐ **Age Requirement** for health professions is to be 18 by June 1st of the year the application is due
- ☐ **Become** a Westmoreland student by applying at <https://apply.westmoreland.edu/>
- ☐ **Submit** an official transcript from your high school (or proof of GED) and from any other colleges attended. A final official transcript must be sent after graduation (high school), if accepted.
- ☐ **Schedule** your placement assessment at https://westmoreland.edu/admissions_aid/apply/placement-assessment-educational-planning.html
- ☐ **Complete** any developmental courses in which you are assessed.
Developmental courses do not count in your Westmoreland GPA.

- ☐ **Submit** all official documentation that applies (including proof that the applicant can legally take radiographs in the state of PA.)
