

Application Deadline: January 12

Thank you for your interest in Westmoreland County Community College's **Medical Assisting** program. This program has requirements in addition to the Application for Admission to the college. Use the checklist below to ensure that you successfully complete all of the requirements to apply to the program.

- Become a Westmoreland student by applying at <u>https://apply.westmoreland.edu/</u>
- **Submit** an official transcript from your high school (or proof of GED) and from any other colleges attended. A final official transcript must be sent after graduation (high school) if accepted.
- Schedule your placement assessment at <u>https://westmoreland.edu/admissions_aid/apply/placement-assessment-educational-planning.html</u>

NOTE: completion of developmental courses may be required based on the results of the placement assessment. Developmental courses do not count in your Westmoreland GPA.

- Attain one of the following by the Program's application deadline of January 12:
 - a minimum 2.0 GPA in 12 or more college-level credit courses at Westmoreland
 - a minimum 2.0 GPA for a student who has not earned 12 or more Westmoreland credits but has earned 15 or more college-level credits at other post-secondary institutions (this GPA will be a composite score representing all institutions attended)
 - a minimum 3.0 GPA from the secondary school (high school) for a student who meets all other criteria but has earned less than 12 college-level credits at a two- or four-year post-secondary institution(s). If accepted prior to high school graduation, your admission will be contingent on having a minimum 3.0 GPA on your final transcript after graduation.
 - a minimum of 165 on the GED or a minimum of 15 on each subtest of HiSET if you have earned less than 12 college-level credits
