 - a minimum 2.5 GPA in 15 or more college-level credit courses at Westmoreland
 - a minimum 2.5 GPA for a student who has not earned 15 or more Westmoreland credits but has earned 15 or more college-level credits at other post-secondary institutions (this GPA will be a composite score representing all institutions attended)
 - a minimum 3.0 GPA from the secondary school (high school) for a student who meets all other criteria but has earned less than 15 college-level credits at a two- or four-year post-secondary institution(s). If accepted prior to high school graduation, your admission will be contingent on having a minimum 3.0 GPA on your final transcript after graduation.
 - a minimum of 165 on the GED or a minimum of 15 on each subtest of HiSET if you have earned less than 15 college-level credits
