FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION FOR SUMMER 2017

STUDENT LOAN INFORMATION

If you already reached the annual maximums for these different types of aid, you won't be able to use them to fund a **summer** semester. You must be taking at least 6 credits for the summer session to be eligible for loan money. If you drop below 6 credits during the summer session, then you are not eligible for any loan money.

You must be registered and/or pass 6 credits to receive your student loan for the summer session.

PELL Grant

You may be eligible to receive the Pell Grant for your summer classes.

For Financial Aid, the award year is Fall, Spring, Summer allowing for **any unused Pell Grant to be awarded in Summer if the student is eligible**

Continuing Students

If a current student already has received the Pell Grant during the previous Fall and Spring semesters, any unused funds remaining from Fall and Spring can be disbursed during summer, based on their enrollment status and academic progress. If the student has exhausted their Pell Grant eligibility prior to summer, they will not receive a summer Pell award.

Eligibility

For Financial Aid purposes, full-time status for Summer is the same as Fall and Spring:

- 12 or more credits = Fulltime
- 11 – 9 credits = Three-quarter (¾) time
- 8 – 6 credits = Halftime (½)
- 5 or fewer credits = Less than halftime

Pell Grant need is based on income and Expected Family Contribution (EFC) as calculated by the Federal formula and Westmoreland County Community College's Cost of Attendance (COA).

Need analysis for Pell - Example

COA - EFC = Need.

Students with the greatest need have a zero EFC – meaning it was determined by the Federal formula that the student/family will be unable to contribute to the student's education. EFC 0 = \$5815 in Pell grant for entire year. If a student attended full-time for Fall and received the full amount of \$2908 and then attended 3/4 time for Spring and received \$2181, unused Pell amount would be \$727 available for Summer. For students that are enrolled in less than half-time (LHT) status, the award will be adjusted accordingly.
