**COMPUTER COMPETENCY (0-3 CREDITS)**

All students will be required to show "computer proficiency" by either transferring or completing a computer course, or by passing an SRU proficiency exam. WCCC students may choose CPT 150.

\* Prerequisite for ENGL 164, but no longer a requirement at SRU. This course may transfer towards the ARTS Enrichment.

\*\* Numerous choices available at SRU

!!! Physician's Assistant, or pre-medicine majors should complete this course at SRU.

Transfer students must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA to be offered admission into Exercise Science.

It is strongly recommended that students complete no more than 30 credits prior to transfer.

Students are responsible for the curriculum requirements at the time of enrollment at SRU. Because the curriculum may change, it is recommended that students occasionally consult with an SRU transfer counselor.
