The fall 2017 enrollment figure of 5,084 was taken from the audit file on October 15, 2017. This figure will be used for reporting purposes.

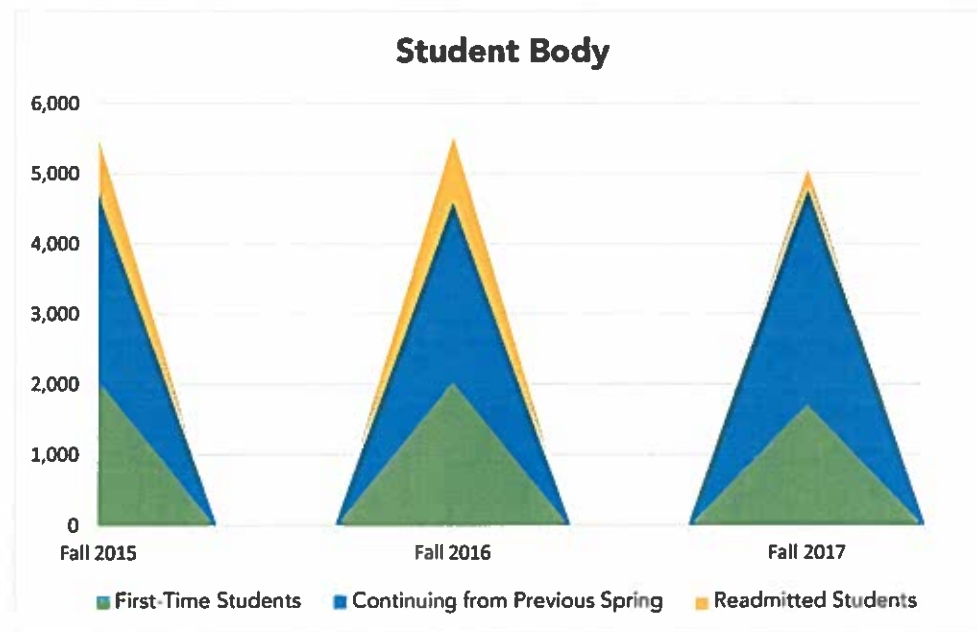

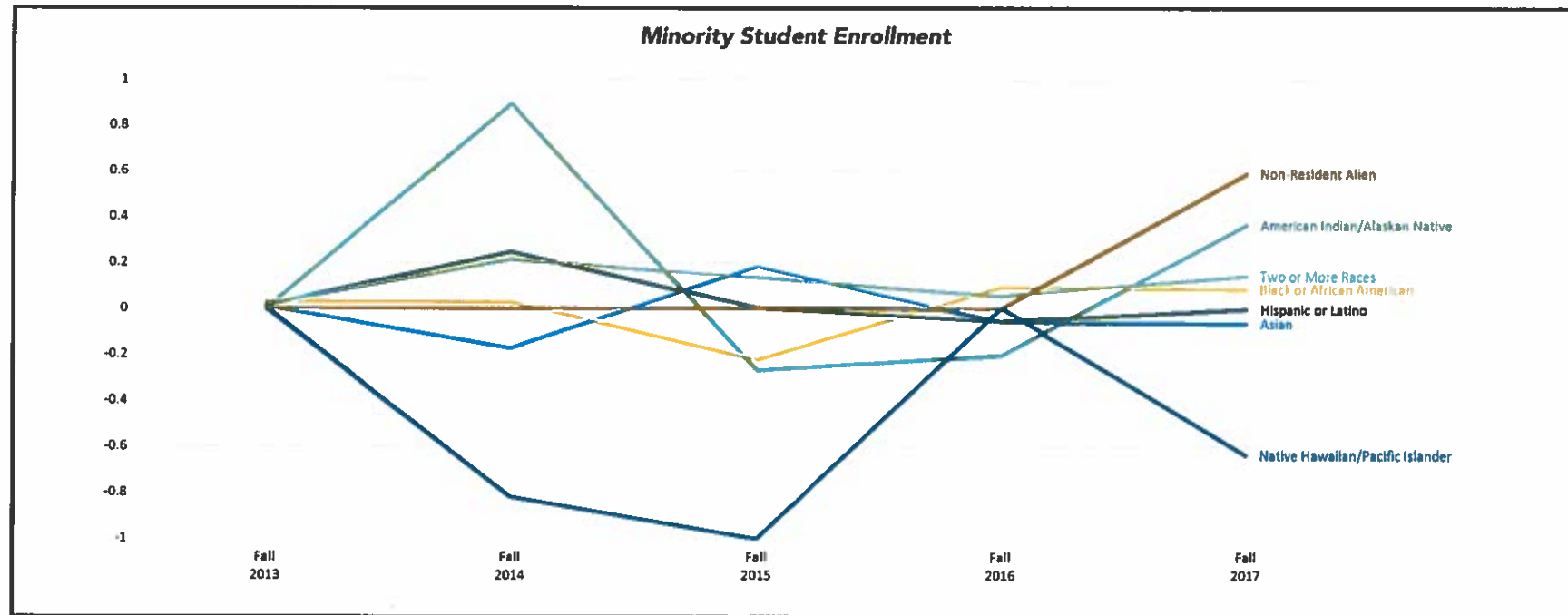
## DEMOGRAPHIC CHARTS

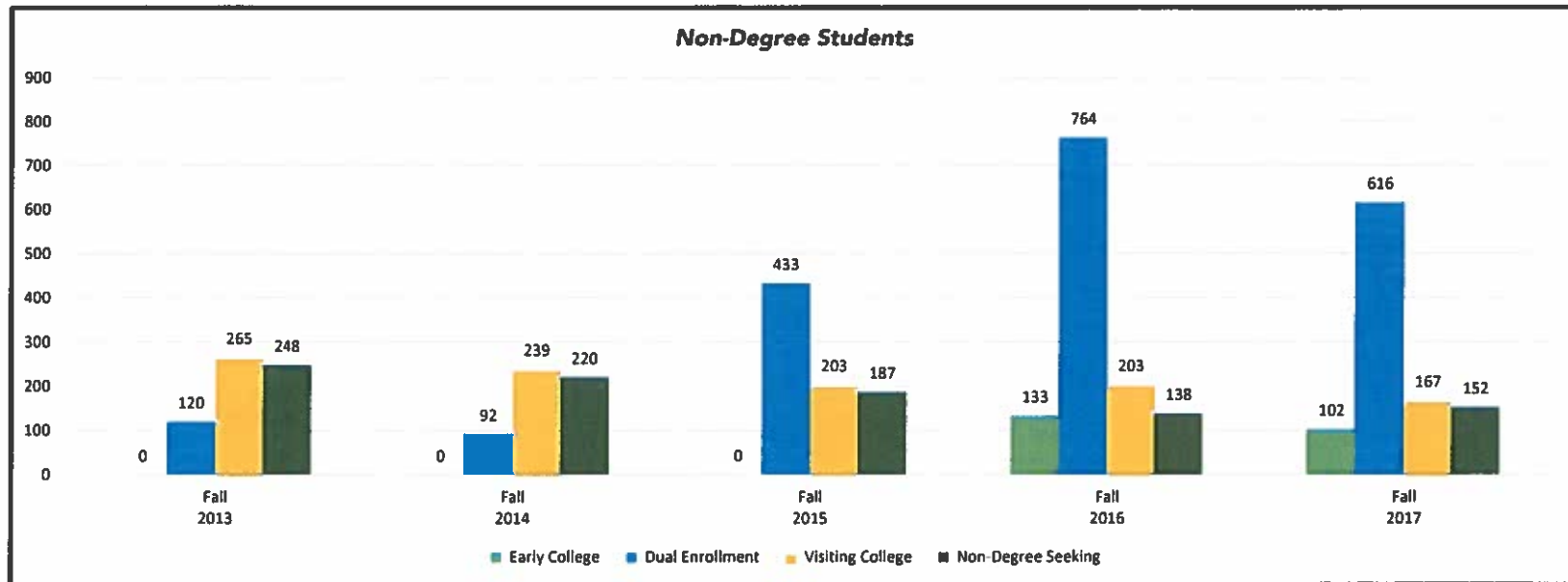
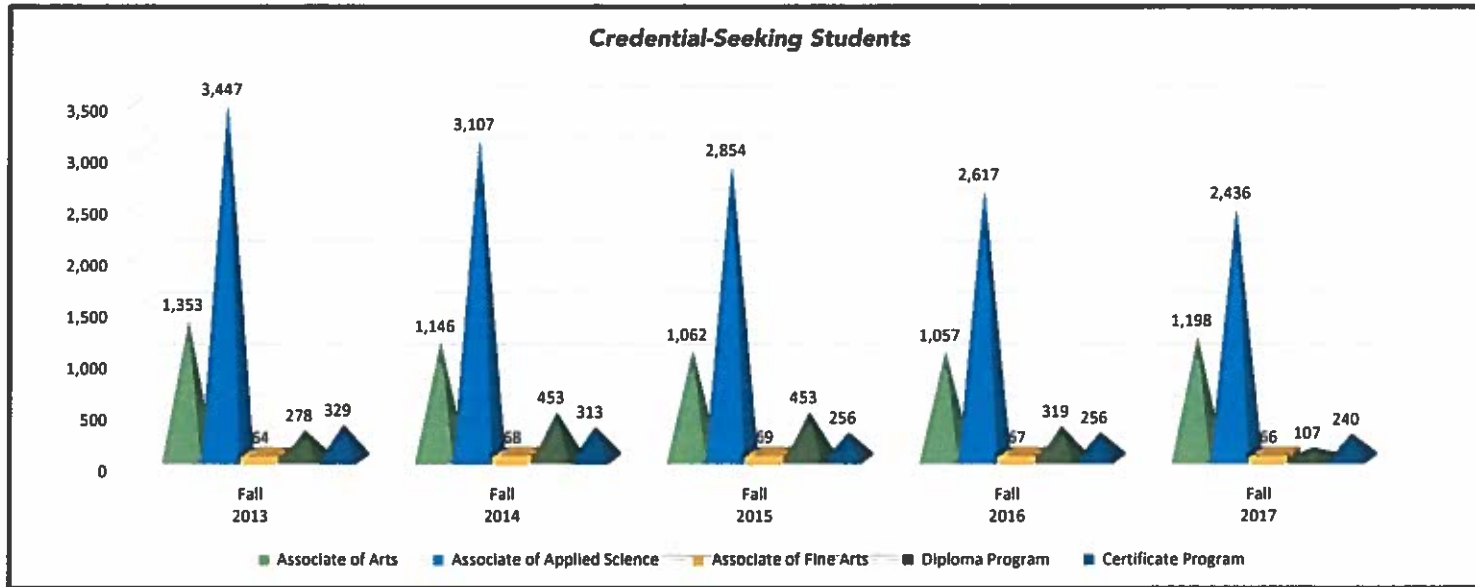

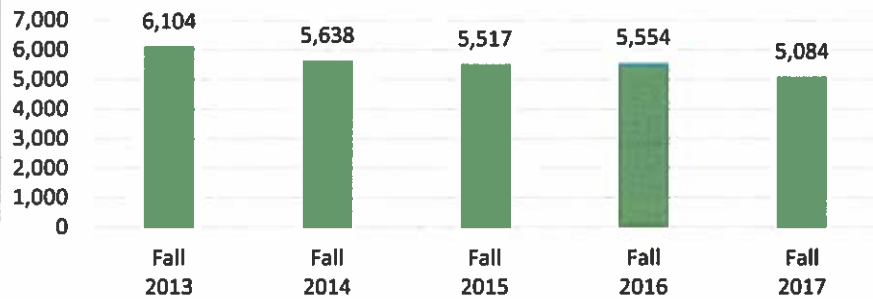

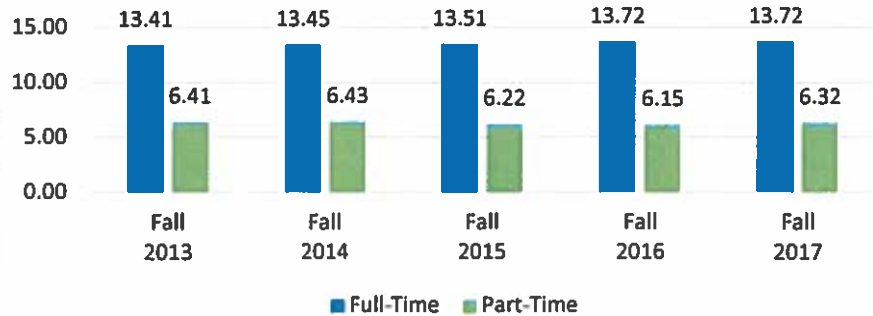
### Unduplicated Headcount



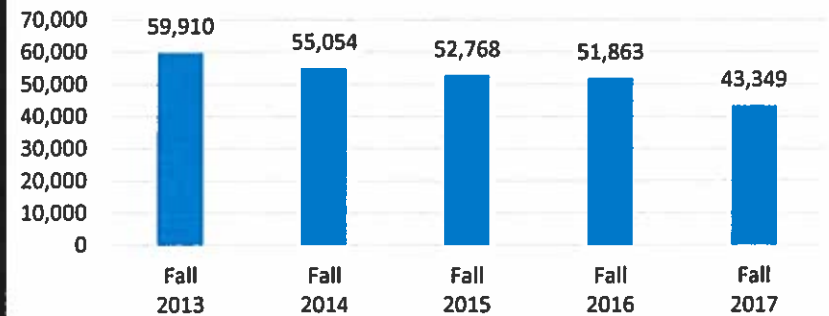
### Full-Time vs. Part-Time

## **GLOSSARY**

*Continuing Students:* Students who enrolled any time during the previous five semesters.

*Dual Enrollment:* High school students who are taking Westmoreland courses at their high school.

*Early College:* High School students who enroll in regularly scheduled online or on-campus courses at Westmoreland.

*Education Centers:* Locations away from the main campus (Youngwood) including Westmoreland-Advanced Technology Center (ATC), Westmoreland-Bushy Run (Murrysville), Westmoreland-Fayette County, Westmoreland-Indiana County, Westmoreland-Latrobe, and Westmoreland-New Kensington.

*Full-Time Equivalent (FTE):* The sum of full-time students and total credits of part-time students divided by 12.

*Full-Time Students:* Students enrolled in 12 or more credits.

*New Students:* Students attending their first undergraduate term at Westmoreland.

*Online:* Asynchronous courses conducted online via a course management system.

*Readmit:* Students who have attended Westmoreland but not within the previous five semesters.

*Traditional Age:* 18-24 years old.

*Unduplicated Headcount:* The unique count of students enrolled in the term.
